MOVE UPS

Dogs may be moved to a higher class at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary, no later than **Monday, November 25, 2024 @ 5:00 p.m.** MT for the Friday or Saturday Trial and 30 minutes after the close of the class moving up from Friday or Saturday for the subsequent days. Dogs so moved will be entered at the end of the running order. Move-ups may be sent in writing or e-mailed to the Trial Secretary. The e-mail move-up will not be official unless acknowledged by the secretary.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL

From the North:

Take I-25 south to Monument (Exit 161). Take Hwy 105 east (away from the mountains) 4.9 miles to Hwy 83. Turn right and go 2.2 miles to Hodgen Road. Turn left and go about 8.6 miles to Meridian Rd (there may no longer be a street sign). Turn right and go 4 miles to Latigo Blvd. Turn left and go 1.1 miles to the second Halleluiah Trail. Turn left and go to the Latigo Trails Equestrian Center on your right (less than 0.1 miles).

From the South:

Take I-25 to Woodmen (Exit 149) in Colorado Springs. Go east (away from the mountains) on Woodmen 11.2 miles to Meridian Rd. Turn left and go 5 miles to Latigo Blvd. Turn right and go 1.1 miles to the second Halleluiah Trail. Turn left and go to the Latigo Trails Equestrian Center on your right (less than 0.1 miles).

PARKING REGULATIONS
